## 2024 Louisiana Master Gardener Program

Thank you for your interest in the Louisiana Master Gardener Program.

The Webster Parish Extension Office of the LSU AgCenter is pleased to announce that we are now taking applications for a new Master Gardener class to be held in the summer of 2024. Applicants are not limited to Webster Parish, but those from all over northwest Louisiana will be welcomed.

Classes are scheduled for 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., one day per week for 11 weeks. Lectures will start promptly at 6:00 p.m. and if you do not have time to eat before you come, you are welcome to bring a sack supper to eat during the lecture. Classes are tentatively scheduled to be held on consecutive *Tuesdays beginning June 18,2024 through September 9,2024*. Classes will be held at the Webster Parish Extension Office at 1202 Homer Road in Minden.

If you are only interested in the educational courses, this program is **not** for you. Upon course completion, **you will be expected to donate 40 hours the first year and 20 hours yearly thereafter of volunteer time** working on local Master Gardener projects and assisting homeowners and youth with information that will improve gardening practices, protect the environment, strengthen character and beautify our communities. Training **volunteers** is the primary objective for this Extension educational program.

Class size is limited and the deadline for applying is May 27, 2024. Applications will be reviewed in May and applicants will be contacted by phone for follow-up questions. You will be notified of your acceptance by mail and given registration information and instructions for submitting payment. There is *a \$165.00 registration fee* to cover the cost of the manual and teaching supplies. If you apply before April 26, 2024, you will receive a \$25 discount. Payment will be received after your acceptance into the class. As a volunteer with LSU AgCenter, you may be asked to complete a background check.
